

Pedigree Wizard 6 - Add data via "Quick Add"

Task	Description	Screenshot
	Introduction - How to add data to PW via "Quick Add".	
A	Set up Quick Add	
A1	In this example we will add weaning weights for animals that are already in Pedigree Wizard. The weaning weights were taken on the 1st September 2012. Click on Quick Add on the home page.	
A2	Ensure the Prefix is the correct breed, flock and year. To change it, click in the box and retype/overtyp the correct number. The Prefix format is, first two numbers = Breed (in this example 25), the next four numbers are the flock code (in this example 0123), the next four numbers are the year (in this example 2012) and the next two numbers are the the last two numbers in the year (in this example 12). Pedigree Wizard uses this information to auto build the unique 16 digit ID number for each animal.	
A3	Choose the "Test Type" from the drop down menu that relates to the approximate age stage for the data you are entering. For example, Weaning = 3 months (40 to 120 days), Early Post Weaning = 6 months (80 to 240 days), Post weaning = 9 months (160 to 340 days), Yearling = 12 months (290 to 430 days), Hogget = 18 months (410 to 550 days) and Adult = 2 years (530 to 1000 days). Choose the age stage nearest to the average age of the animals you are entering.	

<p>A4</p>	<p>Choose the "Info Type" that best describes the data you are entering. Carcase = carcase traits, Fleece = Wool traits and Carcase & Fleece are both. For this example click on Carcase. See the Sheep Genetics website for a table of the traits that can be measured and the age stage they can be collected at. <p>A5</p>	<p>Choose the date the information was collected. Note, you are able to enter measurements for carcase and fleece traits that were taken on different dates.</p>	
<p>A6</p>	<p>Choose the additional information that will appear on the screen when you are entering data. (Useful for when data is being collected and entered and the sheep are also being visually assessed at the same time)</p>	
<p>A7</p>	<p>Tick the appropriate box if Dag score, Scrotal & Fec (WEC) and muscle score are also being entered at the same time. Also tick the box to add comments on individual sheep if you wish (if you do not wish to add comments, untick this box)</p>	
<p>B</p>	<p>Enter data in Quick Add</p>	
<p>B1</p>	<p>Enter the management number of the animal (from 1 to 4 digits) and click on OK, or press enter.</p>	

B2	<p>From the prefix and ID number Quick Add has found the correct animal and displays the full 16 digit ID number. Information previously entered in PW for this animal is also displayed. Type in the weaning weight and press enter to move to the next field.</p>	
B3	<p>Keep pressing enter until the save box appears. Click on Yes or press enter.</p>	
B4	<p>You have returned to the Quick Add set up box where the next animals ID number can be entered. Note, one of the advantages of Quick Add compared to Add/Change (see PW Video 5 - "Add/Change") is that the date the measurements were taken does not have to be typed in for each animal.</p>
